

# My Pile, Your Pile

- First, go through the cards and see which words your child knows.
- Then, add 1- 2 new words from the “I don’t know these” pile.
- Finally, play the game... “My Pile, Your Pile.”

## My Pile, Your Pile

- Show the first card in the stack to your child.
- If they KNOW the word automatically, put in their pile and say, “Your Pile.”
- If they DON’T KNOW the word automatically, put the card in your pile and say, “My Pile.”
- At the end of the game count up how many cards are in your pile and how many are in your child’s pile. The person with the most cards wins.
- This will show you exactly which words to go over and practice with your child.
- Your child should also win the game each time since you are starting with their known words along with a few more. This makes playing again very motivating.

**Aim to get through all 10 cards by the end of the month.**
